In signing this application, we attest that:

- 1. We have answered the questions in this application completely and honestly to the best of our knowledge and ability.
- 2. We agree with Fortis Academy's Mission and Core Values, as well as its educational and spiritual objectives.
- 3. We are committed to providing a quality education rooted in biblical principles for our child and in accordance with existing law.
- 4. We will provide sufficient time and effort to fulfill the parental requirements and responsibilities of each course our child takes, and we will attend/participate regularly and frequently in the meetings and seminars conducted by Fortis Academy for parents.
- 5. We have fulfilled or soon will fulfill the parent resource reading requirement. (This must be done prior to the family interview.)
- 6. We will provide continually updated immunizations and records of such for our attending child.
- 7. We understand that Fortis Academy will provide competent administrators and teachers, a balanced curriculum, regular progress reports to parents, and cooperation with parents.
- 8. We agree that upon the acceptance of our child into Fortis Academy and prior to registration, we will enter into a binding conciliation agreement with Fortis Academy incorporating the following statements:

The parties to this agreement understand that Christian measures are to be upheld in any dispute with each other in private, or, within the community that may arise. Therefore, the parties agree that any claim or dispute arising out of, or related to, this agreement or to any aspect of the school relationship, including any claim or statutory claims, shall be settled by Biblically-based mediation as found in 1 Corinthians 6:1-8, Matthew 5:23-24, and Matthew 18:15-20.

If resolution of the dispute and reconciliation do not result from such efforts, the matter shall then be submitted to a panel of three arbitrators for binding arbitration. The selection of the arbitrators and the arbitration process shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Procedure of Christian Conciliation of the Institute for Christian Conciliation as printed in the <u>Christian Conciliation Handbook</u>.

The parties agree that these methods shall be the sole remedy for any controversy or claim arising out of the school relationship or this agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit against one another in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce legally binding arbitration decision.

Each party, regardless of the outcome of the matter, agrees to bear the cost of his/her/its own arbitrator and one-half of the fees and costs of the neutral arbitrator and any other arbitration expenses.
